Updated versions will include an new markets, user feedback changes and any changes that the NJDEP makes to the Tonnage Grant Program.

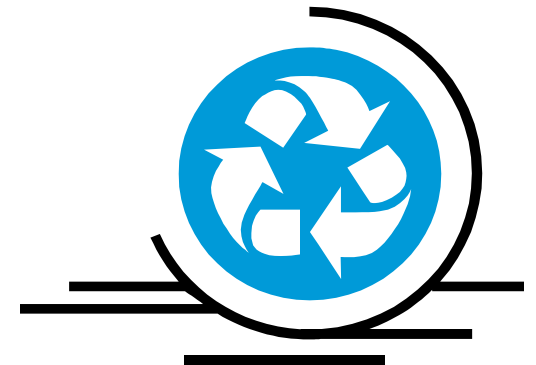

About Tonnage Tracker

Tonnage Tracker was developed by the Middlesex County Division of Solid Waste Management as an alternative means for calculating the Municipal Tonnage Grant that the NJDEP sponsors annually. It serves as a way to electronically compile and analyze your Tonnage data similar to other electronic systems that the NJDEP may no longer accept.

It was developed to work in the Microsoft Office Environment using the Microsoft Access database program which is available as a stand-alone program or included in MS Office Professional that your municipality may already have.

It is intended that Tonnage Tracker will be updated on an annual basis to include new markets and any changes that the NJDEP makes to the Tonnage Grant Reporting process. As well, all user feedback will be considered when new versions are developed.

Data Entry Features

Tonnage Tracker is designed to be updatable by the user whenever pertinent information changes regarding Markets and Generators in your municipality. Any changes the user makes are made throughout the entire database.

The Tonnage entry form is driven through a series of drop-down menus to make it easy to classify your data.

Additionally, tools are included to break out commingled numbers into the constituent commodity materials according to the recognized NJDEP conversion.

Finally, a conversion tool has been included to help convert various materials into tonnage if your market doesn't provide you with that figure.

Report Generation

Tonnage Tracker has two types of reporting built into it. It will provide you with a series of paper reports including a summary report, a Bonus Grant report, Generator Report and finally the NJDEP Report that must be filed with the Division of Solid & Hazardous Waste, Bureau of Recycling & Planning on an annual basis.

There are also a series of electronic reports that will allow the user to easily update their information from year to year. Tonnage Tracker will allow the users to import changes in their Generators and the Markets that they use.

Additionally, through the click of a button an electronic version of the Tonnage Grant is created in a form accessible for submission to the NJDEP.

Please follow the Tonnage Grant manual instructions for submitting your Tonnage Grant to the NJDEP.
